2019 USS JOHNSTON DD-821 Reunion Savannah, GA

Your Association officers have worked hard to make USS Johnston's 2019 reunion the best ever. It will be held in Savannah, GA at the "Holiday Inn" located at 520 Bryan St., Savannah, GA 31401. We have negotiated a special room rate of \$129 for a king and \$139 for 2 double beds (these prices DO NOT include taxes). Discounted overnight parking is available for \$25/night. Breakfast is not included, however, there are discounted \$10 Breakfast buffet vouchers available at the front desk. There is no shuttle service to the hotel from the airport. Uber is the least expensive method at about \$18. Taxi's cost about \$32 per couple. They are available at the airport.

The reunion will start on Monday evening, May 20th with the "Welcome Dinner" being held that night. If you want to attend the entire reunion, it is important to arrive no later than on Monday afternoon as you certainly don't want to miss our Welcome Dinner. We have arranged exciting tours for Tuesday and Wednesday plus a great show at the Historic Savannah Theater on Wednesday evening. Thursday, we will have our business meeting early evening followed by our Farewell Banquet and White Elephant Auction. Five events in total plus our business meeting. The Hotel is providing a Hospitality Room for the reunion, so we can relax and continue to exchange those old sea stories and once again spend time together. The Hospitality Room will be open early morning to late night as required. Please check your "Welcome Packages" for any last-minute details or changes.

*We have really got it set up this year for our tours. There are **two** important issues regarding the busses.*

- 1. **Due to the size of our group, our tours will be on 2 vehicles, both leaving from the hotel at the same time. All seats will be filled on a first come/first serve basis so send your registration form in early. We will number your registration form as received and that will be the order the bus seats are filled in. Once all seats are spoken for, late registrations will also be numbered, and you will get a seat only if space becomes available.***
- 2. **The buses are not equipped for wheelchairs. However, if required, they do have storage for your wheelchair.***

The Historic Savannah Theatre was built in 1818 and designed by renowned architect William Jay. Today the theatre has been restored in the classic 1940's Art Deco style. In its seventeenth year of operation since being restored, you will enjoy a two-hour show. As of the date of this printing, the actual title of the show has not been released. We will let you know asap but request you not hold up booking for the show. No transportation is included, the theater is less than a mile from the hotel and takes about 4 minutes to walk.
