As we've mentioned in the past, we appreciate those of you that make your hotel reservations early and of course, send us your registration as early as possible. We have to set guaranteed numbers for the hotel rooms and meals plus the tour providers we use. If we estimate too high and don't get the required number, the Association has to pay the difference out of our Association account. If we estimate too low, we pay more for the hotel and tours. It's a juggling act to say the least. Please book your room and send in your registration as soon as possible. The forms are included in this newsletter.

I find it interesting to know what my former shipmates have been doing in their lives all these years since I left "J" in 1971. Your story can be a few paragraphs to a page or more. Secondly we would appreciate payment of the yearly dues by the end of January, 2022. We do understand that not all can afford to pay and that is OK. However at \$15/year, you have to admit it's a great deal. At the time of this writing, we have only 62 paying members for 2021 or beyond out of the 289 (about 21%) that are currently listed on our roster. All shipmates on the roster receive our newsletters and have been sent a dues payment form. The dues basically keep the Association afloat by not only paying for the printing of the newsletters but the cost of mailing them also. Dues also help to defray the costs of maintaining the USS Johnston website (www.ussjohnston.org). Now I don't know about you, but in my opinion, our website is second to none. You do the math, each mailing of the newsletter cost about \$230. Sixty-two paying members equals \$930. That barely covers the cost of three mailings and leaves no money for maintaining our website. Extra donations have been our saving grace. Some are now receiving the newsletter IN COLOR via email and that has helped lower our delivery costs. Keep in mind the dues are NOT tax deductible! 2022 USS JOHNSTON DD-821 Reunion New Orleans, LA

Your Association officers have worked hard to make USS Johnston's 2022 reunion the best ever. It will be held in New Orleans, LA at the "Crown Plaza New Orleans French Quarter" located at 739 Canal St., New Orleans, LA 70130. We have negotiated a special room rate of \$109 for your choice of bed (this price DOES NOT include state and local taxes or the state occupancy charge of \$2.00 per room). High speed internet is included in the room price. The hotel phone number is 504-962-0500, make sure to mention the USS Johnston DD821 Reunion for the special pricing. The same pricing is available for three days before and after the reunion in case you want to spend extra time in New Orleans. The hotel is entirely NON-SMOKING. You can also make your hotel reservation using this link:

Overnight valet parking is available at the hotel. If you prefer to park your own car and don't mind a short walk, the Fulton Place Parking Garage, 901 Convention Center Blvd is only 1.3 miles away and is approximately \$12 per night which is considerably less than at the hotel. There are coupons available on the internet for this garage. We suggest you book your parking on-line ahead of time to get the best rate.

There is no hotel shuttle service to and from the airport. We're told that Uber is the least expensive. Of course, taxis are available as well. Both Uber and taxis are available at the airport.

The reunion will start on Monday evening, May 16th with the "Welcome Dinner" being held that night. If you want to attend the entire reunion, it is important to arrive no later than Monday afternoon as you certainly don't want to miss our Welcome Dinner and leave no earlier than Friday. We have arranged exciting tours for Tuesday and Wednesday. Thursday, we will have our business meeting early evening followed by our Farewell Banquet and White Elephant Auction. Four events in total plus our business meeting plus the bonus listed below. The Hotel is providing a Hospitality Room for the reunion, so we can relax and continue to exchange those old sea stories and once again spend time together. The Hospitality Room will be open early morning to late night as required. Please check your "Welcome Packages" for any last-minute details or changes. Most of our shipmates arrive a day or two early and leave the reunion on Friday or a few days later after the reunion.

A bonus "free" ticket to the WWII museum is being paid for by a USS Johnston sailor who wishes to remain anonymous. You will be required to sign up for the free ticket on your registration form, so we have the proper number of tickets. You will be on your own to visit the museum on your schedule. The tickets will be dated for use a few days prior to and after the reunion. The museum is within walking distance at barely over one mile. If you don't want to walk, the local bus runs there on a regular basis and is inexpensive.

The transportation we have arranged for the tours is handicap friendly.

Our Hospitality Room will open at approximately 3:00 pm (possibly earlier so check in earlier if you want). Please come by and pick up your Reunion Package. Snacks and Drinks will be available.

Tuesday Morning, May 17th - JEAN LAFITTE SWAMP TOUR

Our swamp boat tour will cruise deep into the protected bayous of the Jean Lafitte National Park and Preserve, giving us a taste of Louisiana swamp life. We'll see moss draped cypress trees, fascinating plant life and the creatures who make their homes there, such as alligators, snakes, egrets, white-tailed deer, mink and nutria. We will learn why the wetlands are disappearing due to coastal erosion and in turn the efforts to correct the damage it has done and restore this vital habitat.

Our Cajun guide is a native of the area who will share the legends and lore of Louisiana's still untamed wilderness, including their alligators! Our captain is certified to educate and handle live gators and will get our swamp boat deep into alligator habitat while teaching us about alligator life cycle and conservation.

Jean Lafitte Swamp Tours have been featured on Showtime, Fox Sports and Entertainment Tonight. Make sure you bring your camera and capture some of the wildlife.

After the tour, you'll be free to explore New Orleans into the evening. Remember the hospitality room will be open.

Wednesday Morning, May 18th - CREOLE QUEEN HISTORICAL CRUISE WITH LUNCH TOUR

We will gently glide past the historic French Quarter on the beautiful Creole Queen riverboat and experience the Port of New Orleans from the river as our on-board historian entertains and informs us with a detailed narration of New Orleans landmarks, history, vessel information and river lore. We will disembark at the site of the 1815 Battle of New Orleans at the Jean Lafitte National Historical Park and Preserve, where we can tour the Chalmette Battlefield including the Malus-Beauregard House and the Chalmette Monument before we re-board for lunch and the return cruise. After our return to the hotel, you will be free to spend as much time in New Orleans as you like. Remember, our hospitality room will be open.

The hotel is located at 739 Canal Street, New Orleans, LA 70130. We have negotiated a special room rate of \$109/night plus tax and the \$2.00 State occupancy charge for your choice of bed. The discounted price is available for three days both before and after the reunion in case you want to spend more time in New Orleans. Daily in/out Valet parking is available. If you don't mind a short walk and parking yourself, there is the Fulton Place Parking Garage at 901 Convention Center Blvd and is approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from the hotel. Their charge is about \$12 per night which is less than you will pay at the hotel. There are a limited number of rooms at the special rate so the sooner the better to get the best choice of rooms and the special price. Be sure to mention the "USS Johnston DD821 2022 Reunion" to receive the special group rates. To attend the entire reunion, you should arrive no later than the afternoon of Monday, May 16th and not leave before the morning of Friday, May 20th (or later).
