Secondly if you have not already paid your 2022 dues, we would appreciate payment soon. We do understand that not all can afford to pay and that is OK. However at \$15/year, you have to admit it's a great deal. At the time of this writing, we have only 40 paying members for 2022 or beyond out of the 283 (about 14%) that are currently listed on our roster. Ten years ago it was 33%. All shipmates on the roster receive our newsletters and have been sent a dues payment form. The dues basically keep the Association afloat by not only paying for the printing of the newsletters but the cost of mailing them also. Dues also help to defray the costs of maintaining the USS Johnston website (www.ussjohnston.org). Now I don't know about you, but in my opinion, our website is second to none. You do the math, each mailing of the newsletter cost about \$230. Forty paying members equals \$600. That barely covers the cost of two mailings and leaves no money for maintaining our website. Extra donations have been our saving grace. Those receiving the newsletter IN COLOR via email has helped lower our delivery costs. Keep in mind the dues are NOT tax deductible! 2023 USS JOHNSTON DD-821 Reunion Savannah, GA

Your Association officers have worked hard to make USS Johnston's 2023 reunion the best ever. It will be held in Savannah, GA at the "Holiday Inn Savannah Historic District" located at 520 West Bryan St., Savannah, GA 31401. We have negotiated a special room rate of \$169 for a king and \$179 for 2 queen beds (these prices DO NOT include taxes). Discounted overnight valet parking is available for \$30/night. There may be other parking close-by but hasn't been confirmed. Breakfast is not included; however, it has been discounted to \$10.95 for the breakfast buffet and will be billed directly to your room. There is no shuttle service to the hotel from the airport. Uber is the least expensive method at about \$22. Taxi's cost about \$34 per couple. Both are available at the airport.

The reunion will start on Monday evening, May 8th with the "Welcome Dinner" being held that night. If you want to attend the entire reunion, it is important to arrive no later than on Monday afternoon as you certainly don't want to miss our Welcome Dinner. We have arranged exciting events for Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday evening. Thursday, we will have our business meeting early evening followed by our Farewell Banquet and White Elephant Auction. Four events in total plus our business meeting. The Hotel is providing a Hospitality Room for the reunion, so we can relax and continue to exchange those old sea stories and once again spend time together. The Hospitality Room will be open early morning to late evening as required. Please check your "Welcome Packages" for any last-minute details or changes.

There is one important issue regarding the two tours.

Both events, the Riverboat Cruise and the Savannah Theater are within walking distance, so no transportation is included. Both are about 4 to 6 minutes from the hotel, less than three-quarters of a mile. Please arrive on time for each event so you don't miss out. Sorry but there will be no refunds.

Our Hospitality Room will open at approximately 3:00 pm (possibly earlier so check in earlier if you want). Please come by and pick up your Reunion Package. Snacks and Soft Drinks will be available.

Tuesday at Lunch, May 9^{th} - SAVANNAH RIVERBOAT CRUISE WITH LUNCH

The Savannah Riverboat Cruise will go up river towards the ports passing the Talmadge Bridge and then back around down river passing the waving girl until Fort Jackson. There is a chance of the fort firing cannons while we are in the area but not guaranteed. Lunch will be served, and we will all be sitting together. Lunch will feature their signature Savannah Shrimp & Grits, the best Southern Fried Chicken in the South, Chef's Specialty Station, Creamy Macaroni and Cheese, Southern Greens, Seasonal Vegetables, Sweet Potato Souffle, Fresh Fruit, Coleslaw, Cornbread, Dessert and more. Includes non-alcoholic drinks. There is also a cash bar on the boat. The cruise will start about 12:00 noon and end approximately at 2:30. No transportation is included, and it is about a 5- or 6-minute walk from the hotel. This leaves the early morning and late afternoon/evening to do whatever else you want.

The Historic Savannah Theatre was built in 1818 and designed by renowned architect William Jay. Today the theatre has been restored in the classic 1940's Art Deco style. In its twenty-first year of operation since being restored, you will enjoy a two-hour show. As of the date of this printing, the actual title of the show has not been released. However, we will let you know asap but request you not hold up booking for the show while waiting for the show information. No transportation is included, the theater is less than a mile from the hotel and takes about 5 to 6 minutes to walk.

We attended the Historic Savannah Theater the last two times our reunion was in Savannah and both times the show was the hit of the reunion. Our shipmates and their wives talked about the show for years. This schedule leaves Wednesday morning and afternoon for you to do whatever you please.

The hotel is located at 520 West Bryan St., Savannah, Georgia 31401. We have negotiated a special room rate of \$169/night plus tax for a king bed and \$179/night plus tax for 2 queen beds, Sunday thru Thursday. Discounted daily in/out Valet parking is available for \$30/night. There could be other parking close-by, but we have not confirmed that. Breakfast is not included; however, the breakfast buffet has been discounted to \$10.95 and will be billed directly to your room. There are a limited number of rooms at the special rate so the sooner you book, the better to get the best choice of rooms and the special price.
